## CASE DIGEST: Ass'n of Civilian Technicians, Ky. Long Rifle Chapter 83, 73 FLRA 812 (2024)

The Arbitrator issued an award finding that the Agency did not violate the parties' collective-bargaining agreement; 5 U.S.C. § 706(2)(A); or § 7116(a)(7) of the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute<sup>1</sup> (the Statute) when it implemented revised regulations and promptly separated a technician with a pending disability-retirement claim. The Union filed an exception on contrary-to-law grounds. The Authority denied the Union's contrary-to-law exception because it did not establish any deficiencies in the award.
